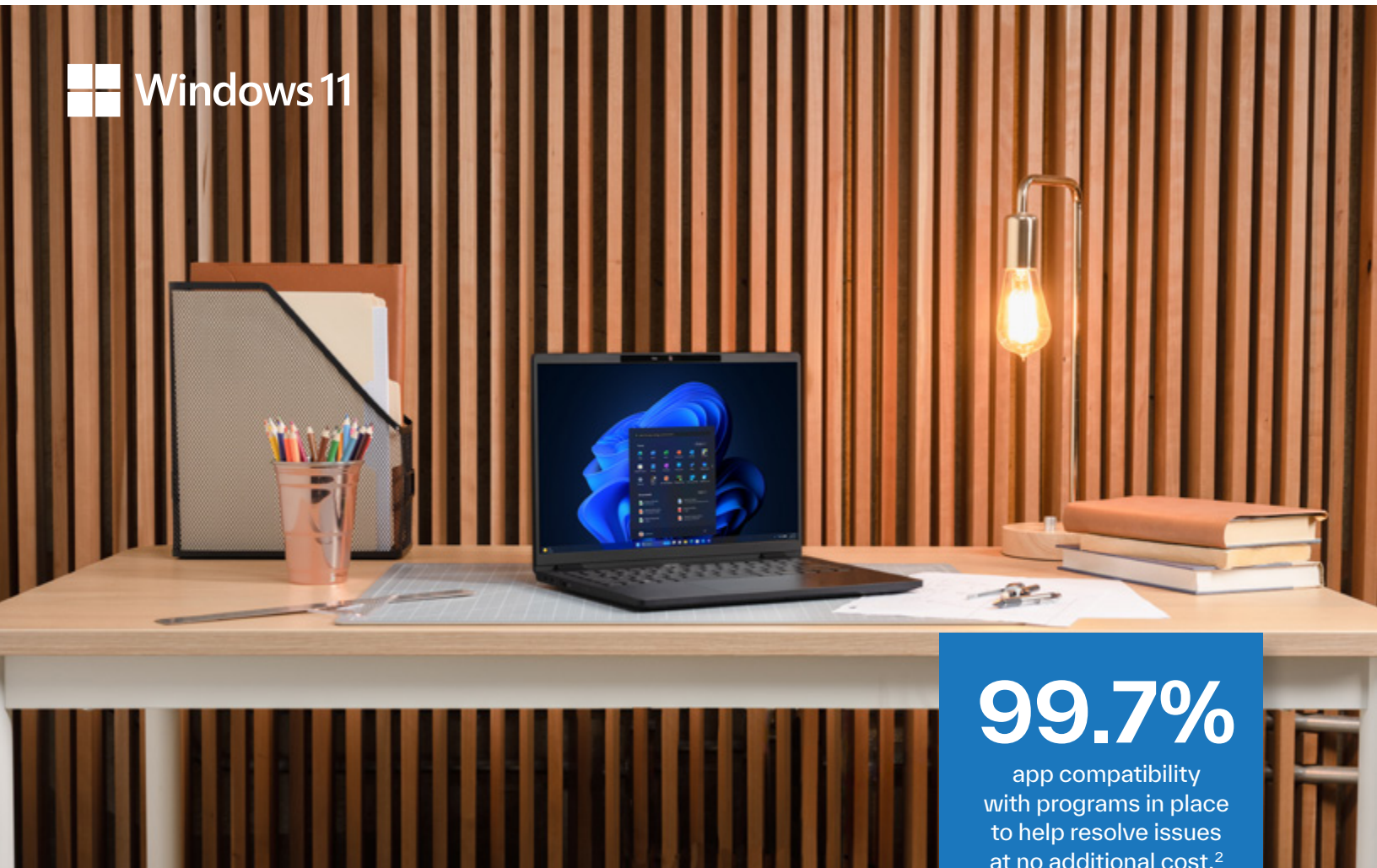

If you use Microsoft Configuration Manager, you can sync the new Windows 11 Pro product category and begin upgrading eligible devices.

If you use Microsoft Intune, analytics at the edge remain the best way for an organization to address checking across the organization for Windows 11 Pro upgrade eligibility information.
